Prior to Placement: Verbal Contact

- Placement Danger Threats*
- Clarify role
- Provide information on issues of care

*If a Placement Danger Threat(s) is confirmed, must locate and transition child to a new placement immediately.

Within 24 Hours of Placement

- Background Checks ◆
- Provisions for care

- ♦ Background Checks include:
- o CCAP and eWiSACWIS records on all individuals 17 years of age and older residing in the identified placement home
- o Reverse Address Sex Offender Registry

Initial Visit: Within 3 Business

- Placement Danger Threats*
- Provisions for care

Days of Placement

Subsequent Visit:

within 7 Business

Days of Initial Visit

- Placement Danger Threats*
- •Confirm expectations and role
- •Issues related to care and provisions
- •Provider's ability to provide care
- View of the child
- When prior relationship exists: provider's understanding of need for placement and child's reactions

Requirements apply to the following:

- Voluntary Placement Agreements, not including respite
- o Emergency TPC Placements
- o Court-ordered Placements
- o Emergency Changes of Placement
