Reconfirming Safe Environments – Unlicensed & Licensed Homes

Timelines and Documentation

- Evaluate at every contact
- Evaluate and confirm every 6 months or at the Permanency Plan Review, whichever comes first
- Document and approve decision making related to assessing, evaluating, and confirming safety in family's eWiSACWIS record

*If a Placement Danger Threat(s) is confirmed, must locate and transition child to a new placement immediately.

Home Visit

- If the following conditions occur, complete all Home Visit requirements identified above:
- Conditions affecting safety change
- Physical address change
- •Report of maltreatment
- •Concern of possible Placement Danger Threats
- •Current Caregiver rates '3' on CANS
- •Placement Danger Threat for another child in the home

Additional Situations Requiring Reconfirmation

> Document and approve decision making related to assesing, evaluating, and confirming safety in family's eWiSACWIS record

- Voluntary Placement
 Agreements, not including respite
- o Emergency TPC Placements
- o Court-ordered Placements
