	Aggressive Behavior	Sexualized Behavior	Other (AODA, MH, other concerning behaviors)
Additional or Special Training for Placement Providers	Caregivers will attend upcoming session on learning de-escalation techniques	Caregivers will learn about appropriate sexual growth and development. This will be accomplished by participating in an upcoming web series.	<p>Caregivers will read provided materials to understand signs and symptoms of illicit drug usage.</p> <p>Caregivers will attend training specific to child's AODA use/mental health disorder and learn what this may look like behaviorally for the child; learn triggers, signs to look for when under the influence, teach care provider coping skills to deal with behaviors.</p>
Additional contact by agency or providers	Crisis Stabilizer: Worker will have a daily check-in at school with child to assess temperament so can plan for any needed adjustments or supports.	Caregivers will transport child to weekly play therapy to address issues of sexual abuse.	<p>Child will participate in weekly drug screens</p> <p>For MH issues: child will participate in regular therapy</p>
Re-arrange Living Arrangements	<p>Caregivers will assure that all items that could readily be used as weapons (e.g. knives) are not accessible to the child.</p> <p>Caregivers will assure that John is not left alone with younger or vulnerable children in the home.</p> <p>Caregivers will look to remove breakable or valuable items in the home.</p>	<p>Caregivers will assure that the child does not share a bedroom with any other children in the home.</p> <p>House rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bedtimes will be staggered • only one person allowed in the bathroom at a time • bedroom doors remain wide open when more than one child is in the room • individual's bedrooms are off limits to other children • additional supervision when more than one child in a room 	Care providers will assure that any alcohol/medications in the home are not accessible to the child.
Other	Caregivers provided after hours number to contact if crisis arises.	<p>Child will not be alone with male care provider Male care provider will not transport child on his own.</p> <p>Strategic Seating: caregivers will assure child does not travel in car next to other vulnerable children; will be in caregivers' view.</p>	<p>Caregivers will maintain knowledge of where and with whom the child is associating.</p> <p>Caregivers will provide therapeutic tools (stress ball, soothing music, etc.) as requested by therapist.</p>
