CANVAS DISTANCE LEARNING PLATFORM INFORMATION

Canvas trainings are self-paced courses that use a blend of activities, quizzes, and discussion in the Canvas platform. These courses will have a 7 day window of completion. Users will be actively engaged with other participants and trainers throughout the course.

Canvas System Requirements:

VILT- VIRTUAL INSTRUCTOR LEAD (ZOOM) DISTANCE LEARNING PLATFORM INFORMATION

Zoom trainings are performed using video chat software to actively engage participants during a 3 hour class period. Participants are expected to engage with video and audio discussions and multiple tools will be used to encourage participation throughout the session. You should expect to participate live, on camera, for the entire training as scheduled.Be aware that some of the images and discussions during class are extremely sensitive, can be triggering, and are inappropriate for children. Please ensure that no children are exposed to the content during this class.



PUBLIC ADOPTION TRAINING: FOSTERING TO FOREVER ∅

Format

(single training)

This 6-hour class is designed for foster parents who have been licensed by the county or private agency, have received foster care placement of a child and have now been identified as the adoptive resource for the child or youth. Pre-adoptive parents will gain an understanding of how to make the transition of being a foster parent to becoming a child's forever parent. The class is to be taken by those that have or will complete specific Foster Parent Foundation modules. It builds upon these modules and expounds on concepts of attachment, grief and loss, child development, and culture. This class highlights new information related to understanding the educational needs of a child or youth who has been in out of home care as well as legal aspects of adoption. The class also includes information on adoption resources that the parent can access currently and anytime in the future through Wisconsin Adoption and Permanency Support Program (WISAPSP).
