

Wisconsin Child Welfare Caseworker Contacts Dashboard

The Caseworker Contacts dashboard provides cumulative information on the extent to which children in Out-of-Home Care are being seen at least once per month by their county worker. It also measures the extent to which that contact is occurring in the home environment. The federal standard is that 95% of children are seen in person at least once per month, and that at least half of those visits occur in the child’s out-of-home care placement. Hovering your cursor over a county will provide that county’s performance metrics for the past eight years.
