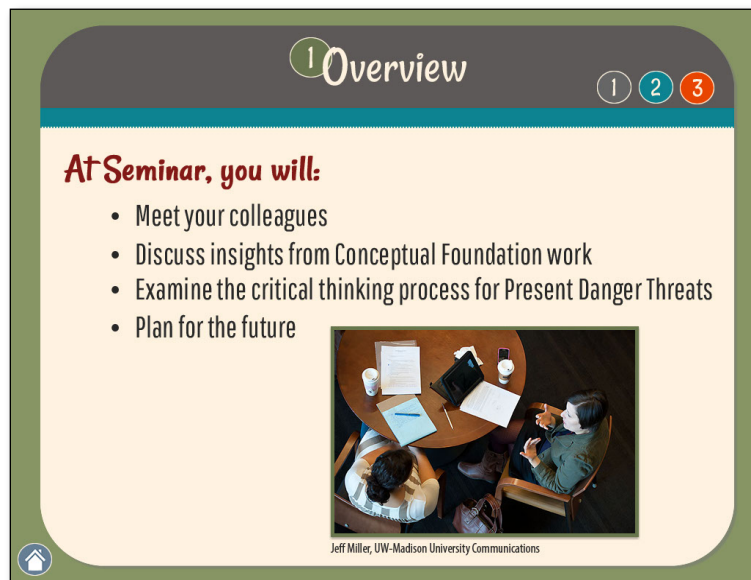




Music and Welcome Seminar
