

Music and Supporting a Worker Assessing Present Danger



During Week 5, we will focus more specifically on your supervision of the workers you support. You have worked on expanding your expertise on Present Danger. Now we are looking at your ability to use that expertise with your workers.

Supervisors have a profound impact on the quality of practice within an agency. They educate and support workers and provide quality control of their work. A supervisor determines whether the work of each individual in the unit meets agency expectations. They ensure that families are getting the services our communities should expect.
