Same for both responses:

Information Required To Gather
Screening Decision Criteria/Response Time Decision-Making

Initial Assessment

Same for both responses:

CPS Access and Initial Assessment Standards & Safety Intervention Standards

- Requirements still apply: information collection and analysis, notifications.
- Assess Present Danger Threats at initial face-to-face contact.
- Develop and implement Protective Plan if Present Danger is identified.
- Assess Parental Protective Capacity.
- Assess Impending Danger Threats.
- Develop and implement Safety Plan if Impending Danger is identified.
- Open for Ongoing Services if child determined to be unsafe.

Initial Face-to-Face Contact

Traditional Response:

Ability to talk with children prior to notifying parents.

Alternative Response:

Contact parents to plan meeting and interviews.

Case Findings

Traditional Response:

Determine if maltreatment has occurred and who the maltreater is, based on evidence.

Alternative Response:

Determine if services are needed or not, based on safety.
